# Schools in the area

Halifax Regional Centre for Education (HRCE) and the Conseil Scolaire Acadien Provincial (CSAP) are both locally represented in the West Bedford area. Kingswood Elementary P-6 offering both English and Early French Immersion Programs, Madeline Symonds Middle School 6-9/7-9 offering English, Early & Late French Immersion, and the newly built Charles P. Allen High School 10-12 offering English, French Immersion and the IB Program option as well.

Ecole Beaubassin offers our French first language families a Maternelle-5 level and Ecole du Sommet is 6-12. Both of these schools also offer a French first language day-care on site.
